


The Bishops Team

Ethical Sourcing & Modern Slavery

Bishops Code of Conduct and related initiatives are committed to high standards of ethical behaviour, from day-to-day business interactions to Community Engagement initiatives.

Bishops acknowledges the responsibility we have in promoting ethical and sustainable business practices for not only ourselves, but all other stakeholders throughout our supply chains. Human rights are of significant importance to all of Bishops' employees, customers and communities surrounding the locations we operate in, and as such Bishops is committed to a journey of ongoing and continuous improvement to ensure the risk of modern slavery within our supply chains is minimised.

Sedex Global

Bishops have partnered with Sedex Global to help manage our ethical sourcing commitments. Sedex provides Bishops with an ethical platform where we can operate responsibly and sustainably. Sedex is also an accredited host of SLCP (Social & Labour Convergence Program) providing a joint assessment framework that aims to improve working conditions in the global apparel and footwear supply chain.

Sedex allows Bishops to maintain data on ethical and responsible practices in four key areas:

- · Health and safety standards
- Labour standards
- Environmental impact
- · Business ethics

Supplier Risk Assessment

We set clear expectations of our suppliers to conduct business in a manner that is ethical and sustainable, and we make known our complete opposition to slavery in all forms.

As part of our Supplier Assurance Programs facilitated by Sedex, we engage with our suppliers through our Supplier Risk Assessment Questionnaire. These assessments are used to understand our suppliers' risk assessment process, their own policies, actions and commitments in relation to reducing the risk of modern slavery in their own supply chains.

As a reseller, we purchase from reputable third-party suppliers who are expected to operate in a safe and ethical manner whilst respecting human rights. We expect these suppliers, as manufacturers, distributors and service providers, to have policies and programs in place to address modern slavery risks within their own supply chain.

Bishops recognises that tackling modern slavery will require a sustained, ongoing and meaningful commitment, and will continue to work with internal and external stakeholders to address our role in minimising the risk across our supply chain.
